Draw Results

Prize Winners

The Draw for the **Cash Prizes** and the **Club Prizes** took place on Friday 26th February 2010 at the Bowls England Men's Dinner at the Walker Stadium, Leicester. Full details of all winners are included in 2 separate lists/files (Cash Prizes & Club Prizes).

All prize winners will be contacted by Graham Clark.

The top three prizes were drawn by Bowls England Women's President Diane Ingle and the subsequent prizes by Kath Lloyd (Friend's Treasurer) and Mike Poole (Friend's Membership Sec.)

The winner of the first (of 35) Cash Prizes was **Gloucester Civil Service BC**, winning £2,500.

Club Prizes were awarded to the 8 Clubs selling the most tickets, whilst all clubs selling £100+ were entered in a separate Club Draw. The top selling Club, with sales of £930 was **Horley BC** from Surrey.

Final Outcome

Although ticket sales were down 22% on 2008; due mainly to the economic environment; total sales of £39,215 generated a 'net gain' of £26,011. Of this sum, more than £19,000 was donated to the selling clubs and almost £7,000 made available to the Friends of English Bowling, to be utilised in support of Bowls England and bowls developments within England.
